

## General Terms of Season Ticket Holder Competitions

1. Rules of Golf: All events shall be played in accordance with the R&A Rules of Golf and in addition to the local rules of Carnoustie Golf Links and the specific Terms of the Competition. All events will be run by Carnoustie Golf Links to whom all disputes will be referred and whose decision will be final.
2. Amateur Status: All players must be of amateur status as defined by the Rules of Amateur Status.
3. Entries & Fees: All entries must be completed and received by 12 noon on the closing date. a) Entry can be made online via the competition entry page. b) Carnoustie Golf Links will only consider late entries should the maximum field size not be achieved. Please contact the Tournament Director for the event regarding late entries. c) If events are over-subscribed, the level of entries will be reduced to maximum field size number through the following methods depending on the event. 1) First come, first served or 2) Handicap Ballot d) If an entrant withdraws after the closing date their withdrawal is final. e) All entries are subject to the approval of Carnoustie Golf Links who reserve the right to refuse or accept or, having accepted, subsequently reject any entry. f) Correspondence will only be sent electronically therefore an email address must be provided. All event information will be available to view on [www.carnoustiegolflinks.co.uk](http://www.carnoustiegolflinks.co.uk). Carnoustie Golf Links will not be responsible for any correspondence that fails to reach the individual.
4. a) All entrants must be in a possession of a WHS handicap index. b) The WHS handicap index certified at close of entry will be used for all purposes. c) It is the entrants' responsibility to ensure that their WHS handicap index is up to date at all times. Carnoustie Golf Links will take no responsibility for any out of date WHS handicap index used for balloting purposes.
5. Reserves a) Entrants who fail to gain entry will be allocated a place on a reserve list in order of time of entry or by handicap ballot depending on the conditions of the competition. b) A reserve list will be maintained and managed by Carnoustie Golf Links. Should a place(s) in the starting field become available, reserves will be invited to play in the order they are listed on the reserve list. c) Should a reserve be unable to be reached, Carnoustie Golf Links event staff reserve the right to contact the next available reserve on the list in order to obtain a full starting field.
6. Withdrawals a) Withdrawals will not be accepted at any time unless confirmed by email to [golfdevelopment@carnoustiegolflinks.co.uk](mailto:golfdevelopment@carnoustiegolflinks.co.uk).
8. Inclement Weather or Exceptional Circumstances: If, in the opinion of Carnoustie Golf Links, it becomes impossible to complete an event in accordance with that event's Terms of the Competition, because of adverse weather or other circumstances, Carnoustie Golf Links reserves the right to amend the event format to the extent necessary to achieve a result within the time available.
9. Trophies/Prizes: All trophies awarded at events shall be retained by Carnoustie Golf Links. Competitors may only win one prize per event. Where a competitor qualifies to win multiple prizes the higher / older age category takes precedent and any other(s) will be awarded to the next eligible competitor(s). Any player not present at the prize presentation who has failed to notify Carnoustie Golf Links will not be presented with their prize.

10. Policies/Procedures: The following policies and rules apply to all Carnoustie Golf Links Events. a) Terms of the Competition b) Local Rules c) Images/Video & Publications – Carnoustie Golf Links arranges publicity before and during the event in the press and by live and recorded radio and television broadcasting and filming and on the internet. Images and filming at the event may be taken for media coverage or promotional purposes e.g. website including social media or publication and these images may be accompanied by personal details such as full name and associated golf club. Parental consent is required for all entrants U16. This will be required to be completed at time of entry. By ticking yes, you give consent for your child to be videoed or photographed.
