1. Eligibility

To be eligible players must be:

- a) Of amateur status as defined by R&A Rules Limited.
- b) A Carnoustie Golf Links Season Ticket Holder and/or Carnoustie Craws Junior Academy Player
- c) Required to have completed Level 1-3 of the 'On The Course' Pathway
- d) Under 14 on 1st January 2021

2. Conditions

- a) The event is a scratch Match Play knockout competition with each match being played over 14 holes.
- b) All play will be from the Green Tees.
- c) All matches will take place on the Burnside course.
- d) The final will take place on **Saturday 5th June at 1.52pm** but all previous rounds of matches will be arranged by competitors on a mutually suitable date. If you cannot make the final date, please do not enter the competition.
- e) All matches must be completed by the end of round date. The end of round dates are as follows:

- g) If any match is an inter-gender match, then 3 strokes are to be given in favour of the girl golfer due to the difference in course rating. The strokes will be taken using the women's stroke index and should be taken at hole 2, hole 4 and hole 8.
- h) If a match results in a tie after 14 holes, extra holes will be played from the 15th hole in a sudden death format. Again, if the match is an inter-gender match, girls would receive strokes on hole 15 and subsequently hole 17 (if the match was to reach this stage). If the match is still tied after 18 holes, play would continue onto the 1st hole. Handicap strokes are given by hole in the same way as during the 18-hole match.
