

On Course Playing Sessions 2023

In addition to the weekly group coaching sessions, there are weekly playing opportunities that all players are encouraged to attend and we hope you will take advantage of the opportunity to play each week. Playing golf on the course is the most important part of improving at this game, as it gives you the chance to apply the skills you learn at the group coaching sessions. By moving through our ON THE COURSE PATHWAY and recording your progress on the My Pathway 2 Golf App will allow all players to do that.

Sunday Afternoon Golf

From 4pm every Sunday (23rd April – 1st October), all players (who are at Levels 1-3 of our ON THE COURSE PATHWAY) are encouraged to come to the Nestie Course (Level 1 & 2) or Burnside Course (Level 3). This will allow you to play together with your friends, record scores that you can upload to the My Pathway 2 Golf App and move up the leaderboard. We would kindly ask parents or a responsible adult to be present at these sessions if you feel your child requires this support – volunteers or PGA Coaches will not be present at these sessions.

Instructions for Nestie Course

If you are at Level 1 or Level 2 of the <u>ON THE COURSE PATHWAY</u> you will play the Nestie Course. Tee times do not have to be booked for the Nestie Course as it is a turn up and play facility. However, we would encourage you to arrange to meet your friends where possible and play together. We would also recommend you join-up with other boys and girls who are waiting to tee off at same time as you. Please do this where possible as this will allow you to make new friends but don't exceed the maximum of 4 players per group. To complete a round should take no longer than 40 minutes. Remember, the Nestie is free to access 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, so you don't have to limit yourself to playing here only on Sunday afternoons.



Instructions for Burnside Course

When you have completed the Nestie Course in 24 shots or less, you will be ready to move to Level 3 of the ON THE COURSE PATHWAY. This takes place on the Burnside Course. The Burnside Course is one of the 18-hole courses at Carnoustie but on Sunday afternoons Carnoustie Craws players will have exclusive use of tee times from 4.00-5.00pm. You will play the course from the orange tees and complete the first 4 holes only, finishing at the 4th green. The short 4-hole course set-up will allow you to progress gradually from the Nestie Course. To complete a round should take no longer than 60 mins. There is a booking process for the Burnside Course and players wishing to play are required to follow the directions below.

- 1. Phone 01241 802290 and let them know you are wanting to book a slot in the Carnoustie Craws Level 3 players reserved for Sunday afternoons between 4.00-5.00pm.
- 2. The starter will take your name and add you to a specific tee time that is available. You may book a tee time from Thursday of each week. If you have friends that are also playing at Level 3, you can book them into a tee time slot with you if you wish. Otherwise, the starter will pair you up with other Level 3 golfers. To help speed of play, the maximum group size will be 3 players.
- 3. If you can't make your tee time for whatever reason, it is important that you cancel your booking by calling the number above. 'No-showing' is not acceptable in golf and may stop someone else who wants to play from playing.



Level 4 and Beyond

When you complete Level 3 (19 shots or better) you will move onto Level 4 of the <u>ON THE COURSE PATHWAY</u>. We will be checking the leaderboards when we can but just if we miss something, please make us aware when you complete Level 3. We will then invite you to take part in the Level 4 & Level 5 playing session that takes place on Friday evenings.

Friday Evening Playing Session

- The sessions will take place every Friday evening on The Burnside or Buddon Course from Friday 21st April until Friday 29th September.
- You will play 9 holes from the black or green tees depending on what level you are at on our <u>ON THE COURSE PATHWAY</u>.
- Tee times will be from 5.15pm-5.45pm and to play, players must follow the booking procedure below.
- It should take approximately 100-120 mins to complete 9 holes.
- One of the PGA Professionals and some of our PVG'd approved volunteers will be there to assist when on the course but if parents are wanting to walk round too, this is encouraged.

Instructions For Booking A Tee Time

There is a booking process for the Burnside/Buddon Course and players wishing to play are required to follow the directions below:

- 1. Phone 01241 802290 and let them know you are wanting to book a slot in the Carnoustie Craws Level 4&5 playing session reserved for Friday evenings between 5.15-5.45pm.
- 2. The starter will take your name and (season ticket holder number if applicable) and add you to a specific tee time that is available. You may book a tee time from Tuesday of each week. If you have friends that are also playing at Level 4&5, you can book them into a tee time slot with you if you wish. Otherwise, the starter will pair you up with other Level 4&5 golfers. To help speed of play, the maximum group size will be 3 players.
- 3. If you can't make your tee time for whatever reason, it is important that you cancel your booking by calling the number above. 'No-showing' is not acceptable in golf and may stop someone else from playing.
