

## Temporary Local Rule – From 31st March 2023

## **Relief from Seams of Cut Turf**

**Course:** Buddon Course

**Hole:** 17<sup>th</sup> Hole

**Purpose:** Due to the returfing works on the 17<sup>th</sup> hole of The Buddon Course, a golfer may encounter an unfair lie where a ball may come to rest on the seam of newly laid turf.

## **Temporary Local Rule**

If a player's ball lies in or touches a seam of cut turf or a seam interferes with the player's area of intended swing:

(a) Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.

(b) Ball on Putting Green. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d.

But interference does not exist if the seam only interferes with the player's stance. All seams within the area of cut turf are treated as the same seam in taking relief. This means that if a player has interference from any seam after dropping the ball, the player must proceed as required under <u>Rule 14.3c(2)</u> even when the ball is still within one club-length of the reference point.

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.
